1 The LORD called to Moses and spoke to him from the tent of meeting. He said, 2 “Speak to the Israelites and say to them: ‘When anyone among you brings an offering to the LORD, bring as your offering an animal from either the herd or the flock.

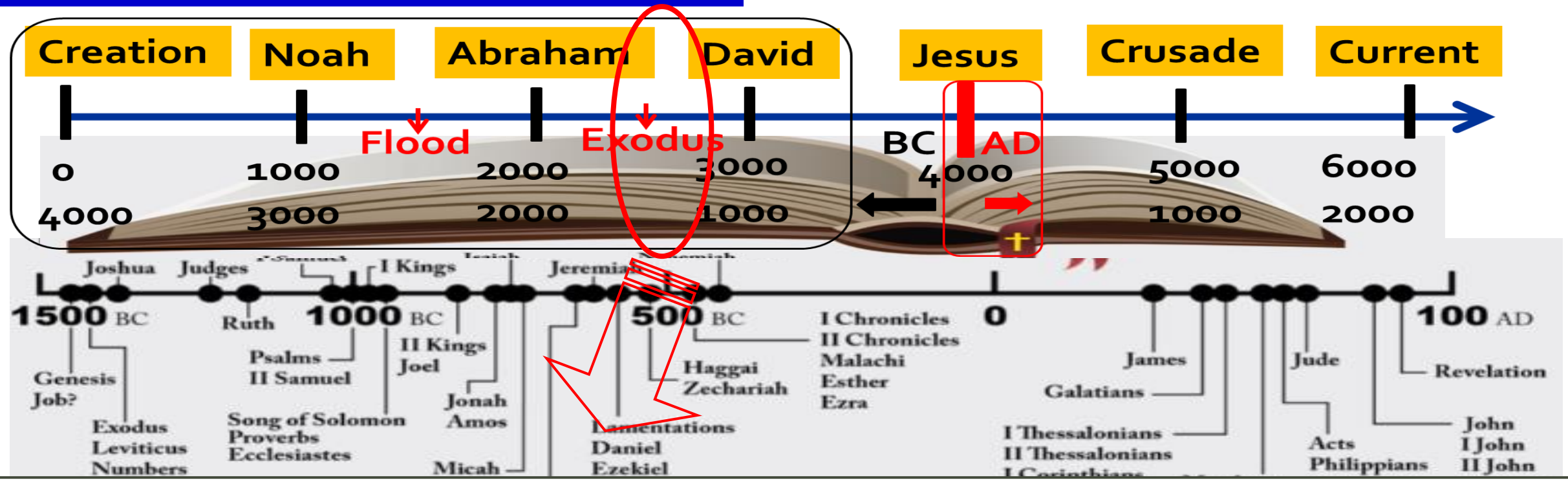
3 “ ‘If the offering is a burnt offering from the herd, you are to offer a male without defect. You must present it at the entrance to the tent of meeting so that it will be acceptable to the LORD.

4 You are to lay your hand on the head of the burnt offering, and it will be accepted on your behalf to make atonement for you.

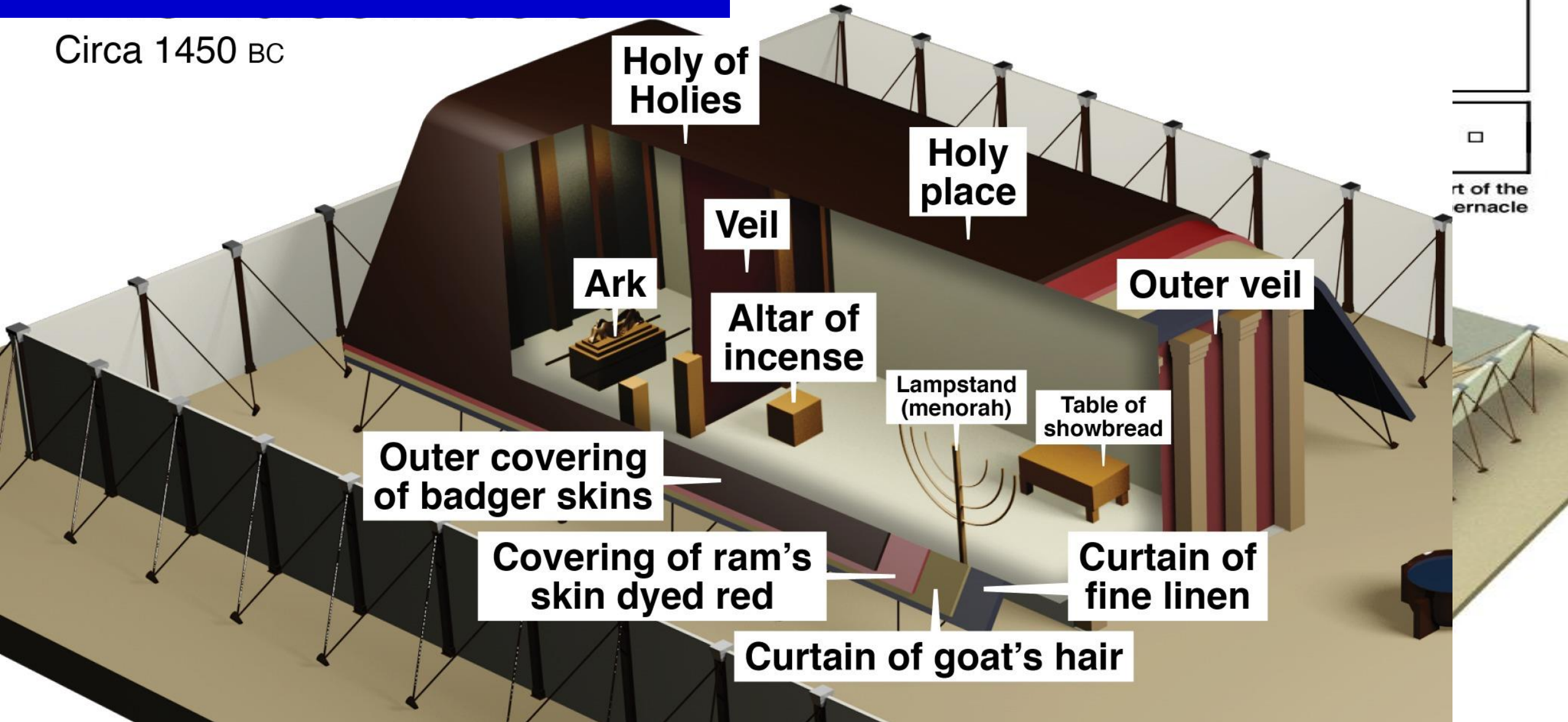

Sacrifice... How?

“Aaron’s sons Nadab and Abihu took their censers, put fire in them and added incense; and they offered unauthorized fire before the LORD, contrary to his command. 2 So fire came out from the presence of the LORD ...and they died ...” -Lev 10:1–2-

“The LORD said to Moses, 2 “Tell Aaron and his sons to treat with respect the sacred offerings ... so they will not profane my holy name. I am the LORD” -Lev 22:1–2-

A Nation, Set Apart...

“The LORD said to Moses, 2 “Speak to the entire assembly of Israel ...‘Be holy because I, the LORD your God, am holy”

-Lev 19:1–2-

“23 You must not live according to the customs of the nations I am going to drive out before you.

Because they did all these things, I abhorred them...

25 “ ‘You must therefore make a distinction between clean and unclean animals ... Do not defile yourselves by any animal or bird or anything ...26 You are to be holy to me because I, the LORD, am holy...” -Lev 20:23–26-


The Perfect Sacrifice...

“the priests shall bring the blood and splash it against the sides of the altar...” -Lev 1:5-

“For the life of a creature is in the blood...It is the Blood that makes Atonement for one's Life” -Lev. 17:11-

“Without the shedding of Blood there is no Forgiveness” -Heb. 9:22-

“he [Jesus] took a cup... had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, “Drink from it, all of you. 28 This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins” -Mt 26:27–28-
