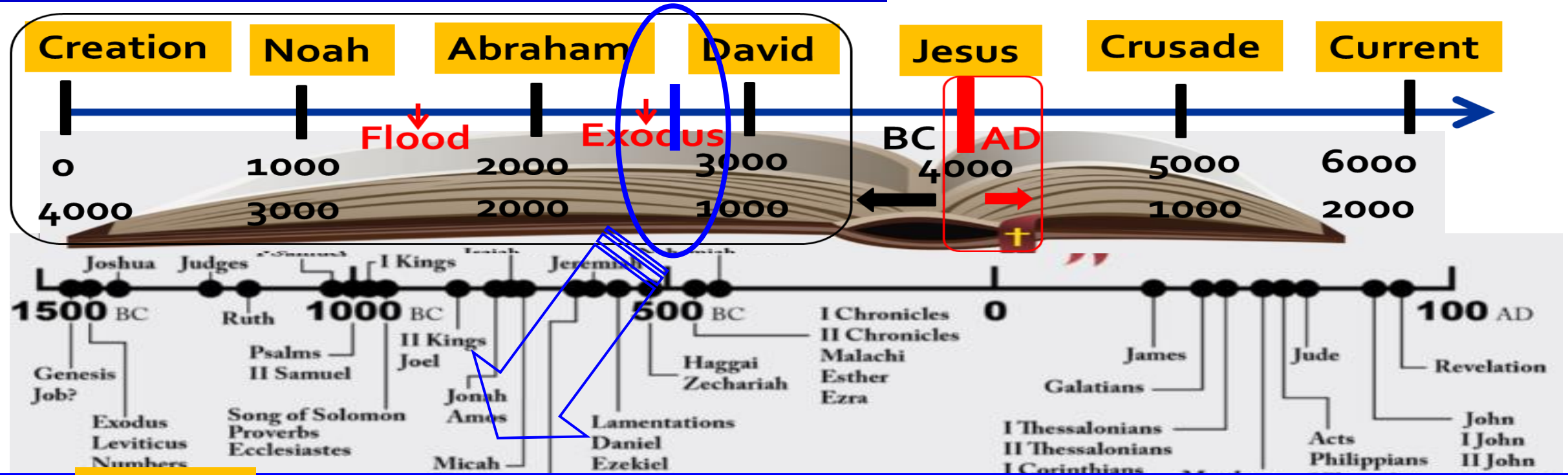
## **Deuteronomy 6:4–9**

Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. 8 Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. 9 Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.**

# For Forty Years...

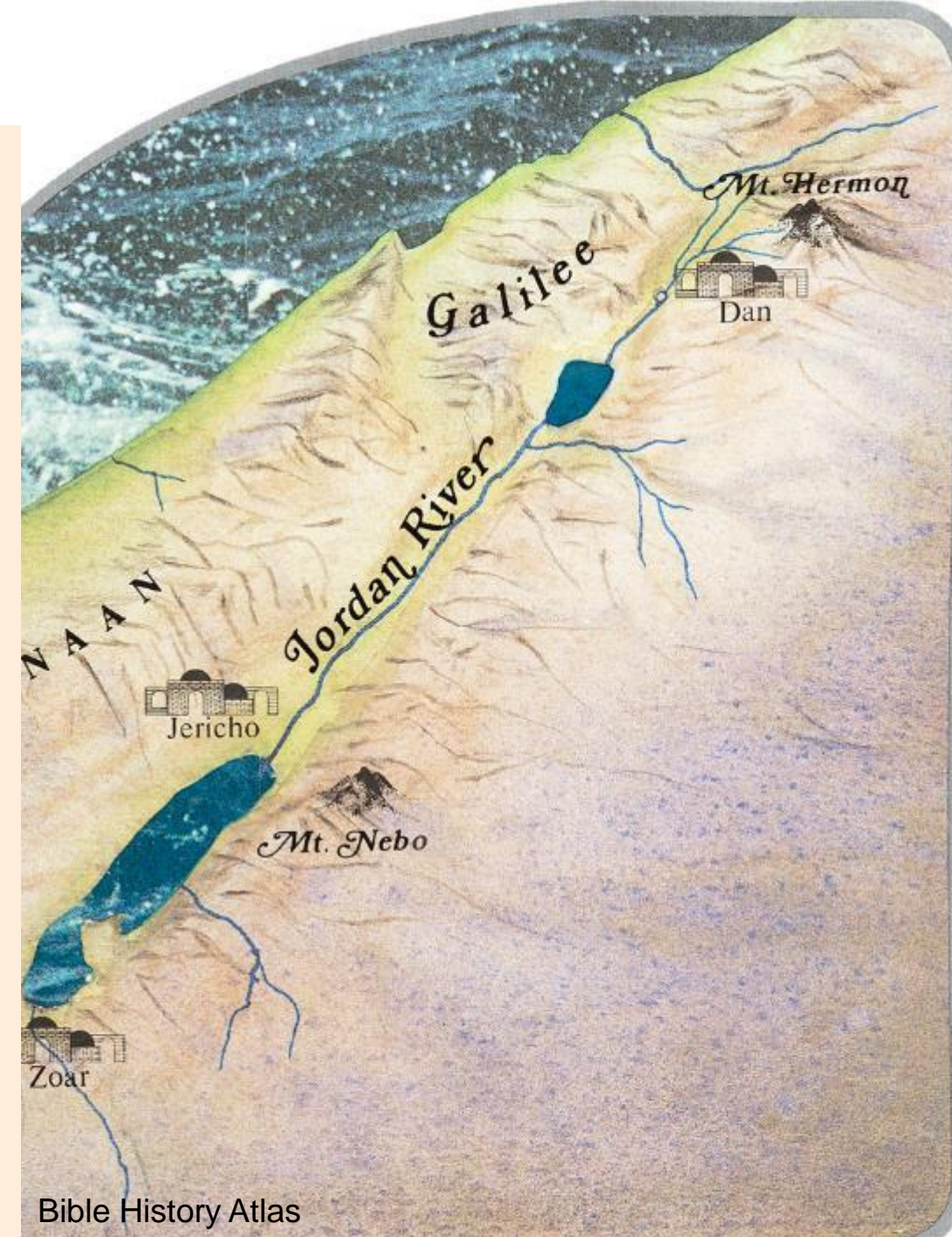
**“Remember how the LORD your God led you all the way in the wilderness these forty years, to humble and test you ...whether or not you would keep his commands. 3 He humbled you, causing you to hunger ...to teach you that man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of the LORD”**

**-Dt 8:2–3-**



# Why this Land?...

**“...You are now about to cross the Jordan to go in and dispossess nations ... 3 But be assured today that the LORD ...goes across ahead of you ...He will destroy them ...do not say to yourself, “The LORD has brought me here to take possession of this land because of my righteousness.” No ... It is not because of your righteousness ...but on account of the wickedness of these nations... for you are a stiff-necked people” -Dt 9:1–6-**

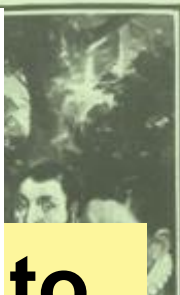
