Deuteronomy 4:1-3

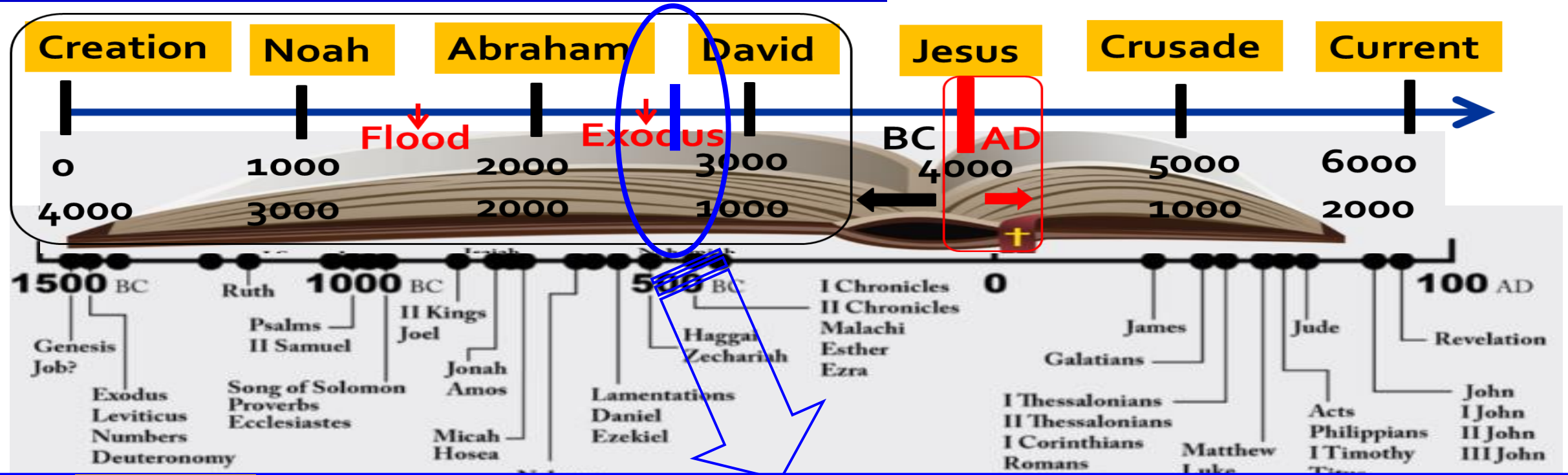

The code of laws: the Idols

“When you enter the land ...do not learn to imitate the detestable ways of the nations there.

10 Let no one be found among you who sacrifices their son or daughter in the fire, who practices divination or sorcery, interprets omens, engages in witchcraft, 11 or casts spells, or who is a medium or spiritist or who consults the dead ...because of these same detestable practices the LORD your God will drive out those nations before you”

-Dt 18:9–12-

Baal from Tortosa (Tartus, Syria)

“You Must Purge the Evil”

**“If a prophet...
announces to you a sign
or wonder ...says, “Let
us follow other gods ...”
3 you must not listen to
the words ...The LORD
your God is testing you
to find out whether you
love him with all your
heart ... You must purge
the evil from among
you.” -Dt 13:1–9-**

**THE LORD said... I will raise up for
them a prophet like you [Moses]
from among their fellow Israelites,
and I will put my words in his
mouth. He will tell them everything
I command him...**

**21 You [Israel] may say...“How can
we know when a message has not
been spoken by the LORD?”**

**22 If what a prophet proclaims
...does not ...come true, that is a
message the LORD has not spoken.
That prophet has spoken
presumptuously...” -Dt 18:17–22-**

Authority of the Bible?

“Thus says the LORD: ‘About midnight I will go out in the midst of Egypt...’-Ex 11:4-

Inspired by God...

“All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training...” -2 Tim 3:16-

Illuminated by the Holy Spirit...

“On the Lord’s Day I was in the Spirit, and I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet, 11 which said: “Write on a scroll what you see...” -Rev 1:10–11-

Authority of the Bible?

“The grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of our God endures forever” -Is 40:8-

“As the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return to it without watering the earth ...so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire ...” -Is 55:10–11-

“It is easier for heaven and earth to disappear than for the least stroke of a pen to drop out of the Law” -Lk 16:17-

“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God” -Jn 1:1-

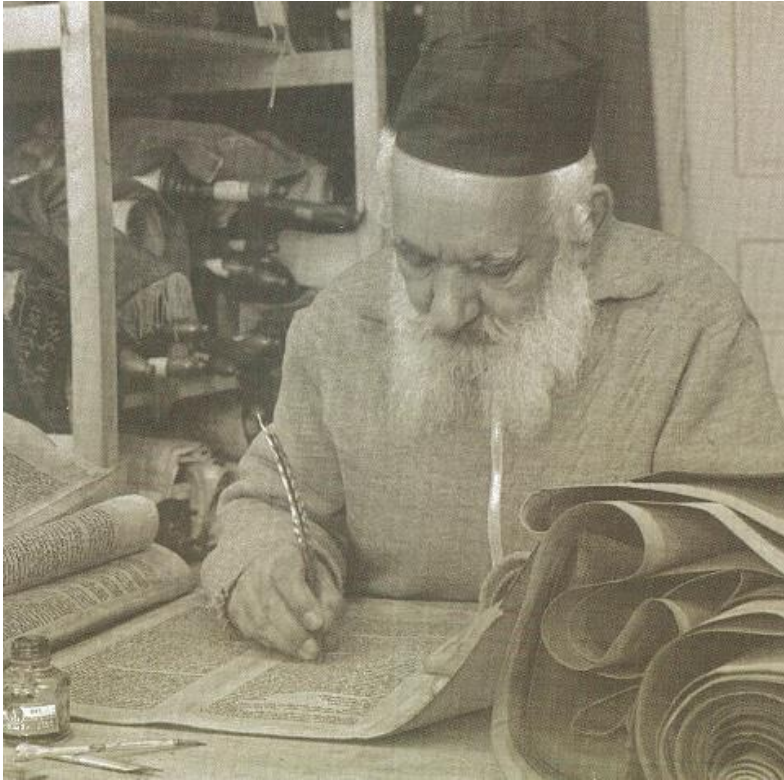

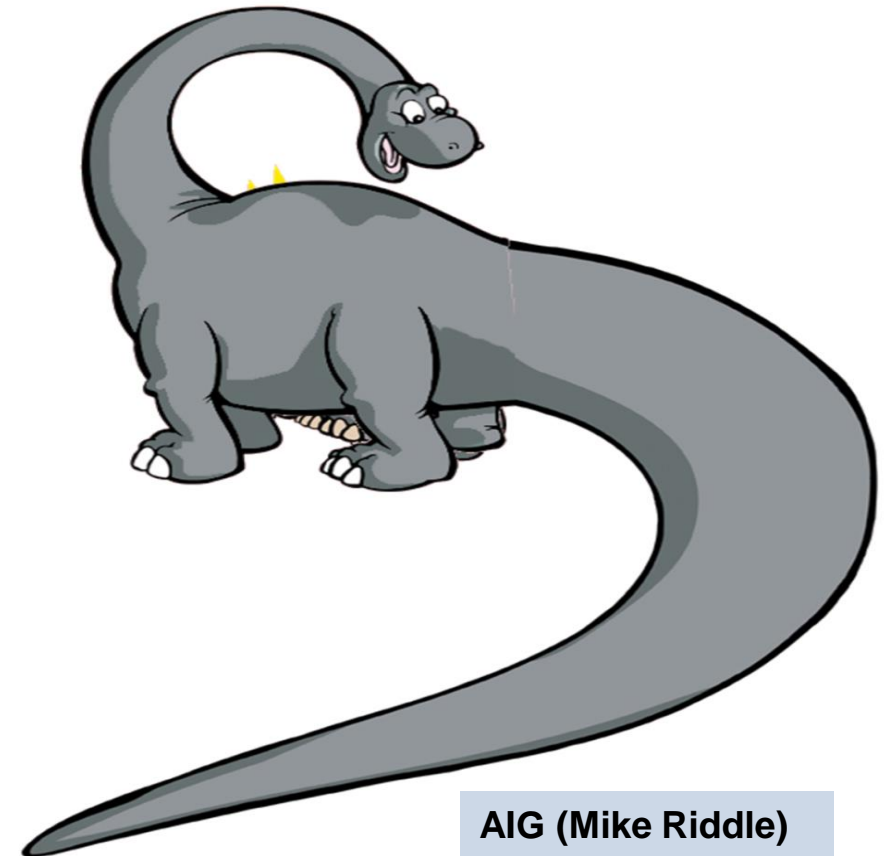
