1 After the death of Moses the servant of the LORD, the LORD said to Joshua son of Nun, Moses' aide: 2 "Moses my servant is dead. Now then, you and all these people, get ready to cross the Jordan River into the land I am about to give to them—to the Israelites. 3 I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses.

Joshua 1:1-6

4 Your territory will extend from the desert to Lebanon, and from the great river, the Euphrates-all the Hittite country-to the Mediterranean Sea in the west. 5 No one will be able to stand against you all the days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you. 6 Be strong and courageous, because you will lead these people to inherit the land I swore to their ancestors to give them.

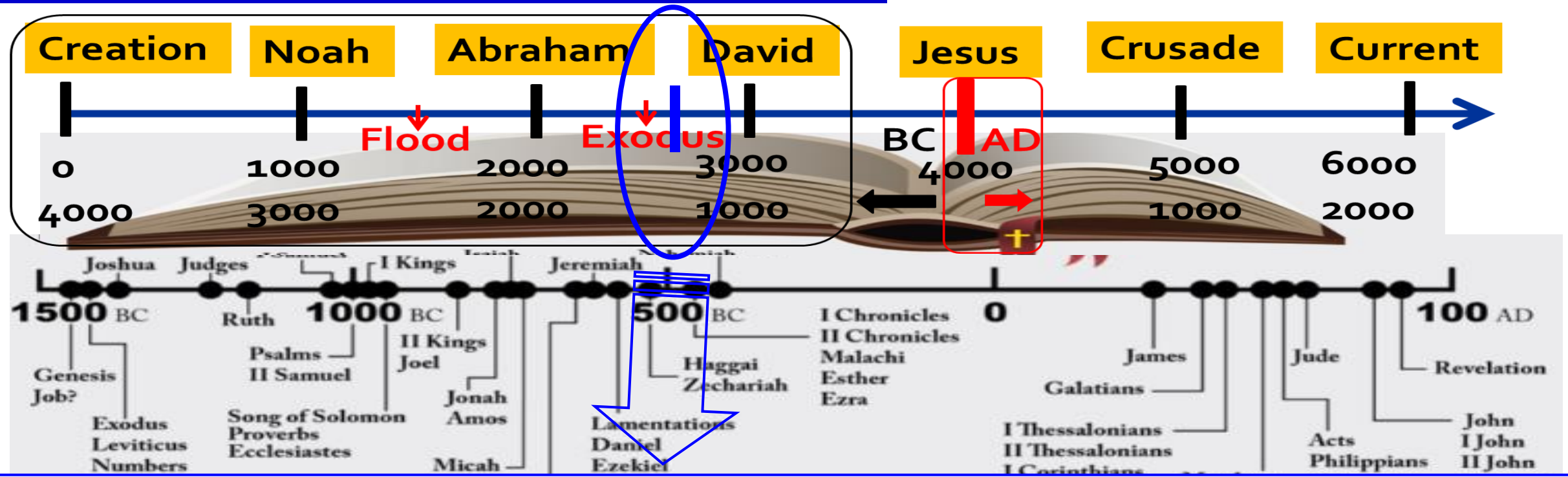

and I myself will be with you.”**

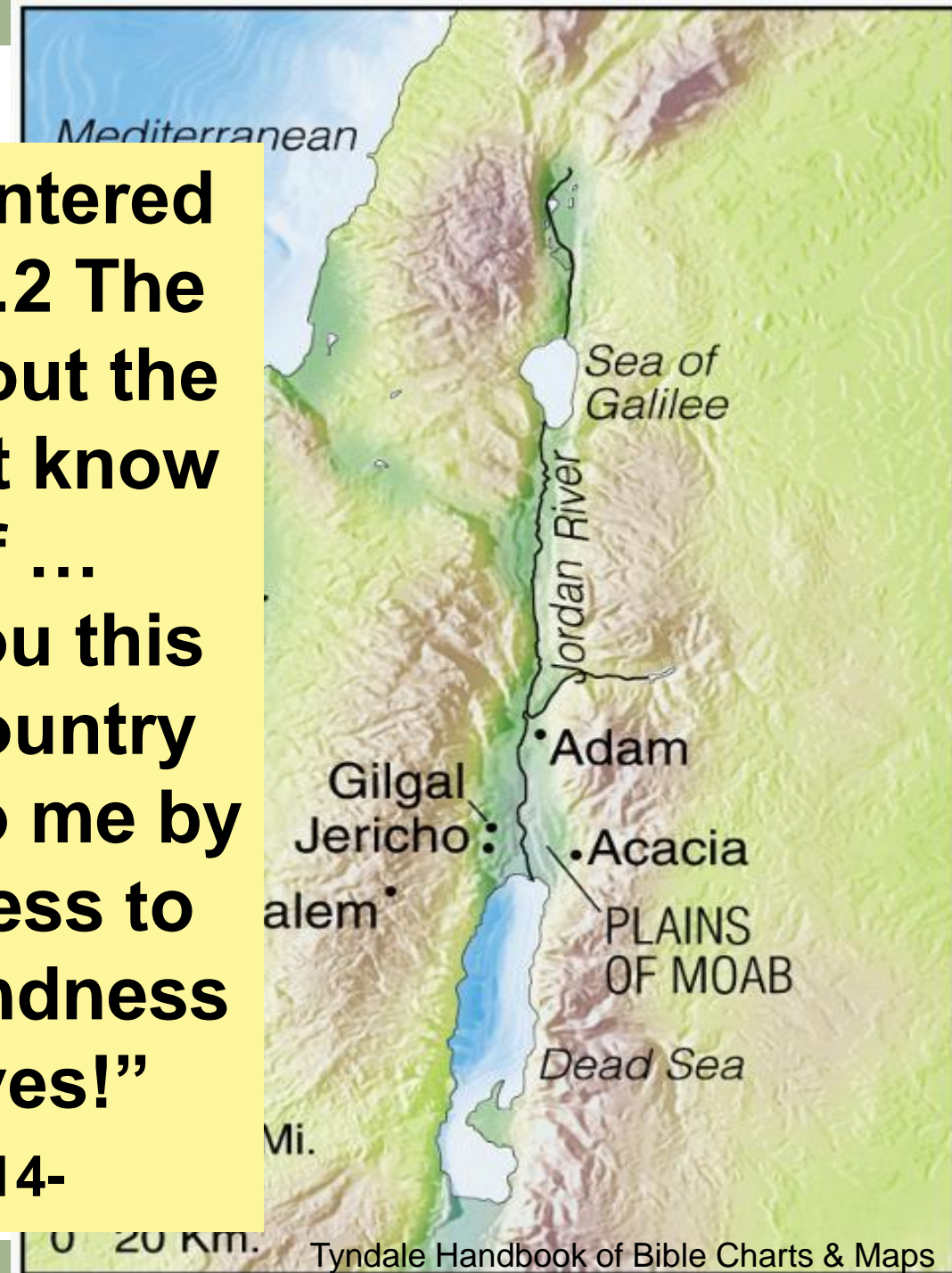

“Then Joshua ... sent two spies ...entered the house of a prostitute...Rahab ...2 The king of Jericho was told ...: “Bring out the men ...4 But ...She said, “...I did not know where ...she went up on the roof ...

“I know that the LORD has given you this land ...so that all who live in this country are melting in fear ... please swear to me by the LORD that you will show kindness to my family, because I have shown kindness to you ... 14 “Our lives for your lives!” the men assured her...” -Jos 2:1–14-



Across the Jordan River

**“Joshua told the people,
“Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the
LORD will do amazing things among you”
...See, the ark of the covenant of the Lord
...will go into the Jordan ahead of you ...
Now the Jordan is at flood stage all during
harvest. Yet as soon as the priests ...reached
the Jordan and their feet touched the water’s
edge, 16 the water from upstream stopped
flowing. It piled up in a heap a great distance
away ...So the people crossed over opposite
Jericho” -Jos 3:5–16-**



The Divine Commander

“when Joshua was near Jericho, he ...saw a man standing in front of him with a drawn sword ...and asked, “Are you for us or for our enemies?” 14 “Neither,” he replied, “but as commander of the army of the LORD I have now come.” Then Joshua fell facedown to the ground in reverence...?”

The Conquest of Jericho

“On the seventh day, they ...marched ...seven times ...when the priests sounded the trumpet blast, Joshua commanded the army, “Shout! For the LORD has given you the city! ...Only Rahab the prostitute and all ...in her house shall be spared ...But keep away from the devoted things, so that you will not bring about your own destruction ... the army shouted ... the wall collapsed...” -Jos 6:15–20-



“So Joshua ...called the priests ...“Take up the ark ...have seven priests carry trumpets ...” Advance! March around the city” ...the seven priests ... went forward, blowing their trumpets. ...But Joshua had commanded ...“Do not give a war cry ...until the day I tell you ... So he had the ark of the LORD carried around the city, circling it once. Then the army returned to camp ...” -Jos 6:6–11-

“You shall not Covet ...”

“ ...the next morning Joshua had Israel come forward by tribes, ...Judah was chosen ...the Zerahites ... Zimri ...Achan ...was chosen. 19 Then Joshua said to Achan, “My son, give glory to the LORD... Tell me what you have done...20 Achan replied, “...I have sinned ...When I saw in the plunder a beautiful robe ... silver and ...gold ...I coveted them and took them” -Jos 7:16–21-

“... Joshua ...took Achan ...the silver... robe... gold ...sons and daughters... cattle ...his tent and all ...to the Valley of Achor. 25 Joshua said, “Why have you brought this trouble on us? The LORD will bring trouble on you today.” ...all Israel stoned him, and ...they burned them ... Then the LORD turned from his fierce anger” -Jos 7:24–26-
