1 Samuel 3:1–10

1 The boy Samuel ministered before the LORD under Eli. In those days the word of the LORD was rare; there were not many visions. 2 One night Eli, whose eyes were becoming so weak that he could barely see, was lying down in his usual place.

3 The lamp of God had not yet gone out, and Samuel was lying down in the house of the LORD, where the ark of God was. 4 Then the LORD called Samuel. Samuel answered, “Here I am.”

5 And he ran to Eli and said, “Here I am; you called me.” But Eli said, “I did not call; go back and lie down.” So he went and lay down...

1 Samuel 3:1–10

8 A third time the LORD called, “Samuel!” And Samuel got up and went to Eli and said, “Here I am; you called me.” Then Eli realized that the LORD was calling the boy. 9 So Eli told Samuel,

“Go and lie down, and if he calls you, say, ‘Speak, LORD, for your servant is listening.’ ”

So Samuel went and lay down in his place.

10 The LORD came and stood there, calling as at the other times, “Samuel! Samuel!” Then Samuel said, “Speak, for your servant is listening.”



Hannah's Prayer

for I delight in your deliverance.**

Eli, a 'Careless Father'

**“Now it was the practice ...whenever ...people offere sacrifice, the priest’s serva would com
pronged fork
into the pan
fork brought u
take ... But
servant ...say
some ...if you
force”**

“This sin of the young men was very great in the LORD’s sight... treating the LORD’s offering with contempt” -1 Sa 2:17-

**“Now Eli... heard about everything ...said ...“Why do you do such things?
...His sons, however, did not listen ...
for it was the LORD’s will to put them to
death. 26 And the boy Samuel continued
to grow in stature and in favor with
the LORD and with people”**

-1 Sa 2:22–26-

Prophecy Against Eli's House

**“Now a man of God came to E
...” Why do you scorn my
...offering ...?**

**Why do you honor your sons
more than me ...? ...**

**the LORD declares: Those
who honor me I will honor,
but those who despise me
will be disdained. 31 The time
is coming ...all your
descendants will die in the
prime of life...” -1 Sa 2:27–34-**

**“the Israelites went out to
fight against the Philistines
...was defeated... the elders
...asked ...Let us bring the
ark ...so that he may
...save us ... the ark ...came
into the camp, all Israel
raised such a great shout ...
the Israelites were defeated
...The ark ...captured, and
Eli's two sons... died”**

Samuel Called...

“The boy Samuel ministered before the LORD under Eli. In those days the word of the LORD was rare...

**10 The LORD came ...calling as at the other times,
“Samuel! Samuel!”
...Samuel said, “Speak, for your servant is listening.”
11 And the LORD said to Samuel...”-1 Sa 3:1–11-**

**“The LORD was with Samuel ...
he let none of Samuel’s words fall to the ground.
20 And all Israel from Dan to Beersheba recognized that Samuel was attested as a prophet of the LORD ...4
And Samuel’s word came to all Israel”
-1 Sa 3:19–4:1-**

Covenant at Mizpah

“... Samuel said ...“If you are returning to the LORD with all your hearts, then rid yourselves of the foreign gods ...and commit yourselves to the LORD ...and he will deliver you out of the hands of the Philistines.” ... they confessed, “We have sinned against the LORD...” -1 Sa 7:2–6-

“Then Samuel took a suckling lamb and sacrificed it ...He cried out ...on Israel’s behalf, and the LORD answered him” -1 Sa 7:9-

“the Philistines drew near to engage Israel in battle ...the LORD thundered ...threw them into such a panic ... Israel ... slaughtering them ... 12 Then Samuel took a stone and set it up ...named it Ebenezer, saying, “Thus far the LORD has helped us” -1 Sa 7:10–12-
