1 Samuel 18:5–9

Whatever mission Saul sent him on, David was so successful that Saul gave him a high rank in the army. This pleased all the troops, and Saul's officers as well. 6 When the men were returning home after David had killed the Philistine, the women came out from all the towns of Israel to meet King Saul with singing and dancing, with joyful songs and with timbrels and lyres.

1 Samuel 18:5–9

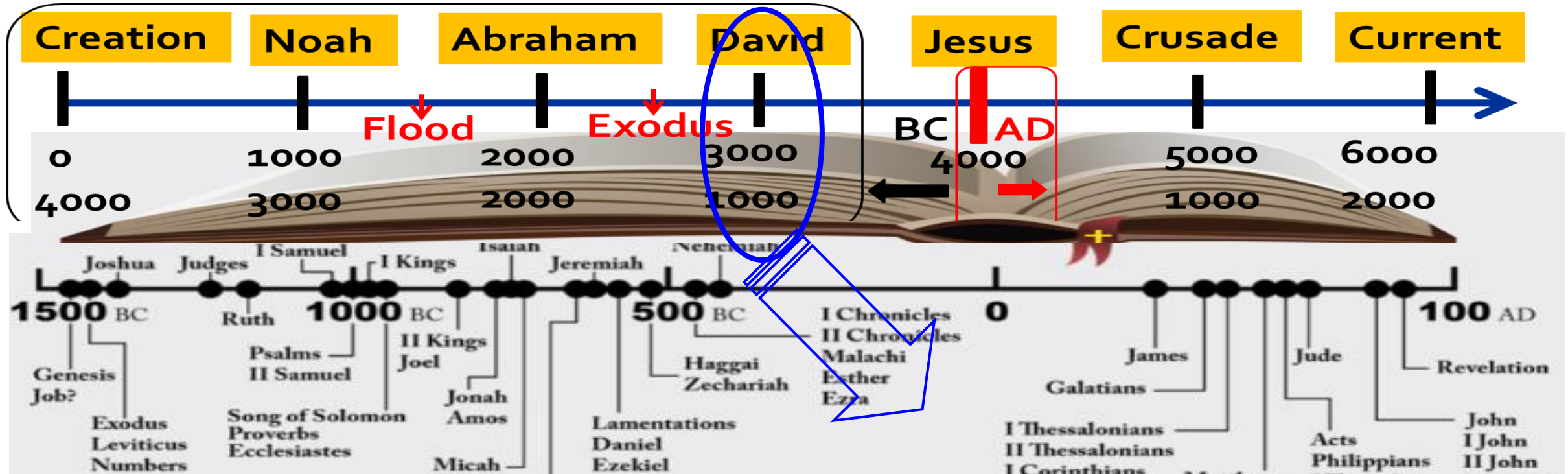
7 As they danced, they sang: “Saul has slain his thousands, and David his tens of thousands.” 8 Saul was very angry; this refrain displeased him greatly.

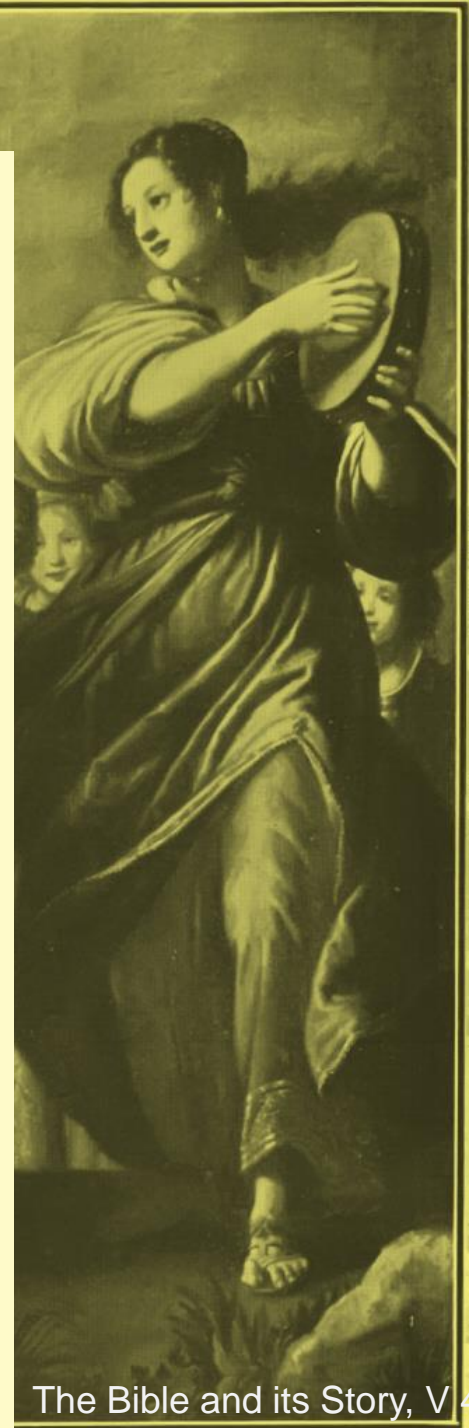
David, the Hunted

“Saul has slain his thousands, and David his tens of thousands.” 8 Saul was very angry ...from that time on Saul kept a close eye on David. 10 The next day an evil spirit from God came forcefully on Saul... while David was playing the lyre... Saul had a spear ...and he hurled it... “I’ll pin David to the wall.” ...12 Saul was afraid of David...

So he sent David away ...

16 But all Israel and Judah loved David”

-1 Sa 18:6–16-



Saul & the Spirit...

**“But an evil spirit from the LORD came on Saul as he was sitting in his house with his spear in his hand. While David was playing the lyre,
10 Saul tried to pin him to the wall with his spear, but David eluded him ...made good his escape”**

-1 Sa 19:9–10-

“Word came to Saul: “David is in Naioth ...” 20 so he sent men to capture him.

Saul went to Naioth ...

But the Spirit of God came even on him ...prophesying ...24 He stripped off his garments... prophesied in Samuel’s presence... This is why people say, “Is Saul also among the prophets?”

Angels are...:

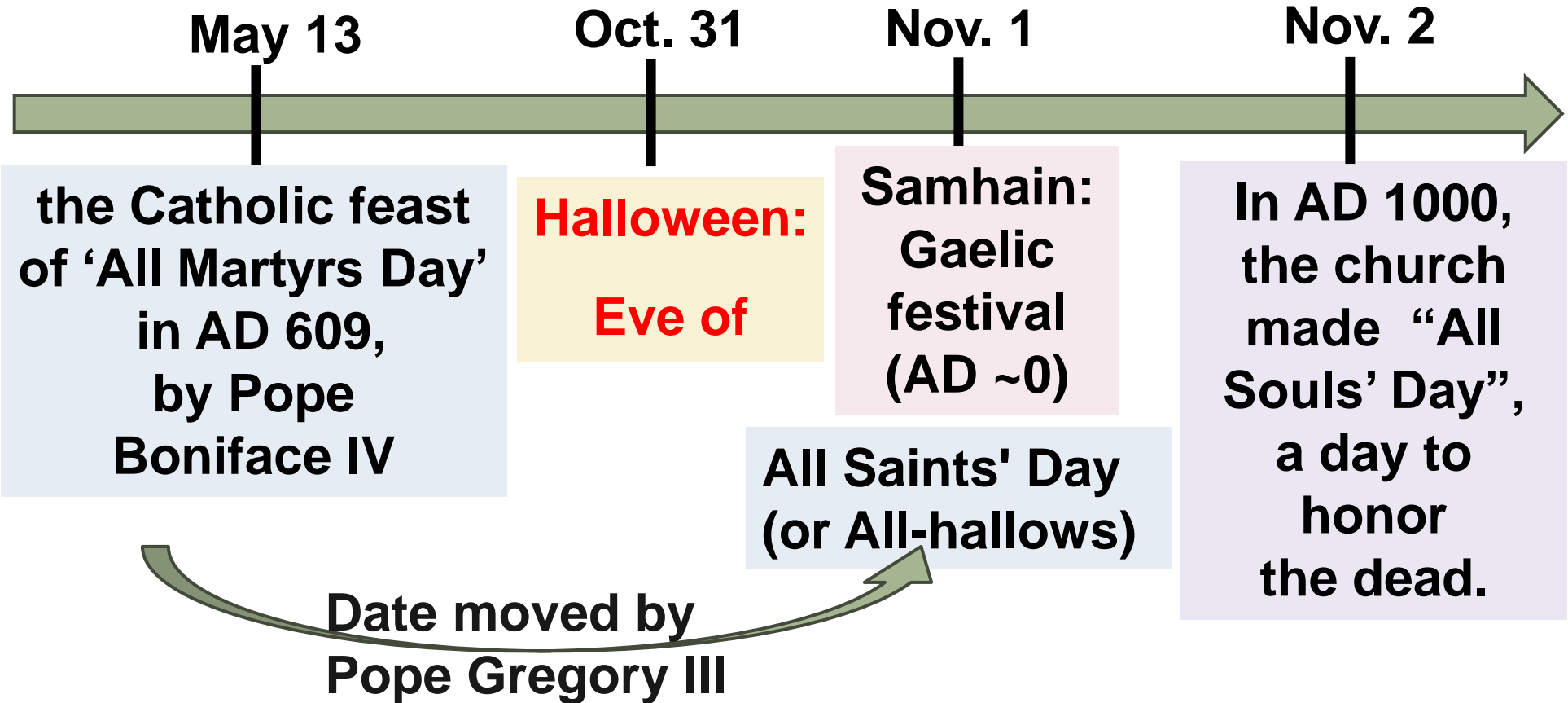
“Creatures, not the Creator”

Halloween (or All Hallows' Eve)



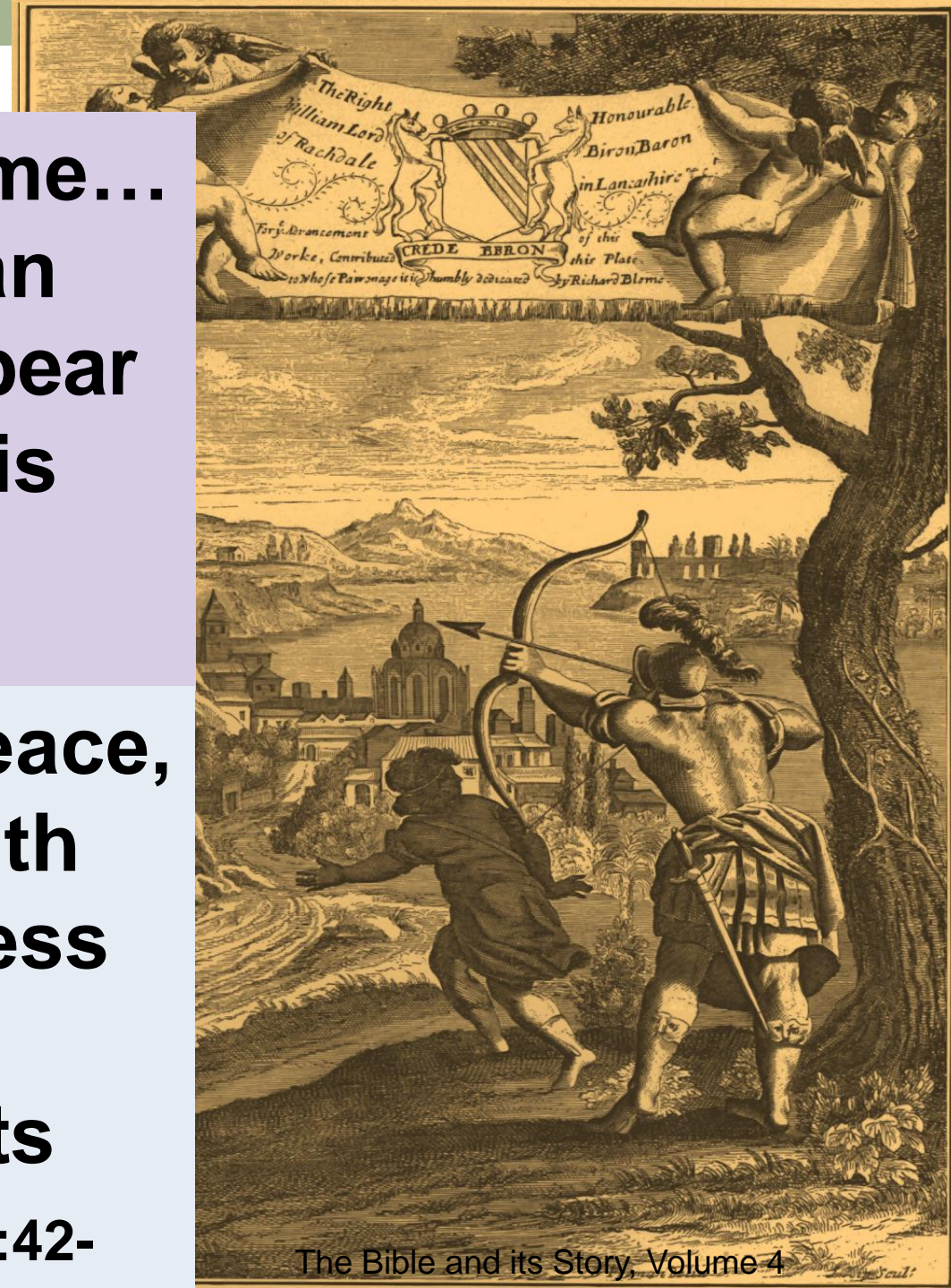
"Samhain was when the boundary between this world and the otherworld thinned, so the 'spirits could easily come into our world'"

descendants ... my descendants

David, the Hunted

**“a cave was there... Saul went in to relieve himself. David and his men ...back in the cave... David crept up unnoticed... cut off a corner of Saul’s robe...
“...my father, look at this piece ... in my hand! I cut off ... but did not kill you... Saul asked, that your voice... he wept alone
17 “You are more righteous than I” -1 Sa 24:3–17-**

“...Saul went down ...to search ...for David... David and Abishai went to the army by night... Saul, lying asleep inside the camp... David took the spear... water jug ...and ...left... Abner ...David said... Why didn’t you guard your king?... Saul said, “I have sinned... I will not try to harm you again” -1 Sa 26:2–21-
