2 Samuel 11:2–4

2 One evening David got up from his bed and walked around on the roof of the palace. From the roof he saw a woman bathing. The woman was very beautiful, 3 and David sent someone to find out about her. The man said, “She is Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam and the wife of Uriah the Hittite.” 4 Then David sent messengers to get her.

2 Samuel 12:10–13

Now, therefore, the sword will never depart from your house, because you despised me and took the wife of Uriah the Hittite to be your own.'

11 "This is what the LORD says: 'Out of your own household I am going to bring calamity on you. Before your very eyes I will take your wives and give them to one who is close to you, and he will sleep with your wives in broad daylight. 12 You did it in secret, but I will do this thing in broad daylight before all Israel.' 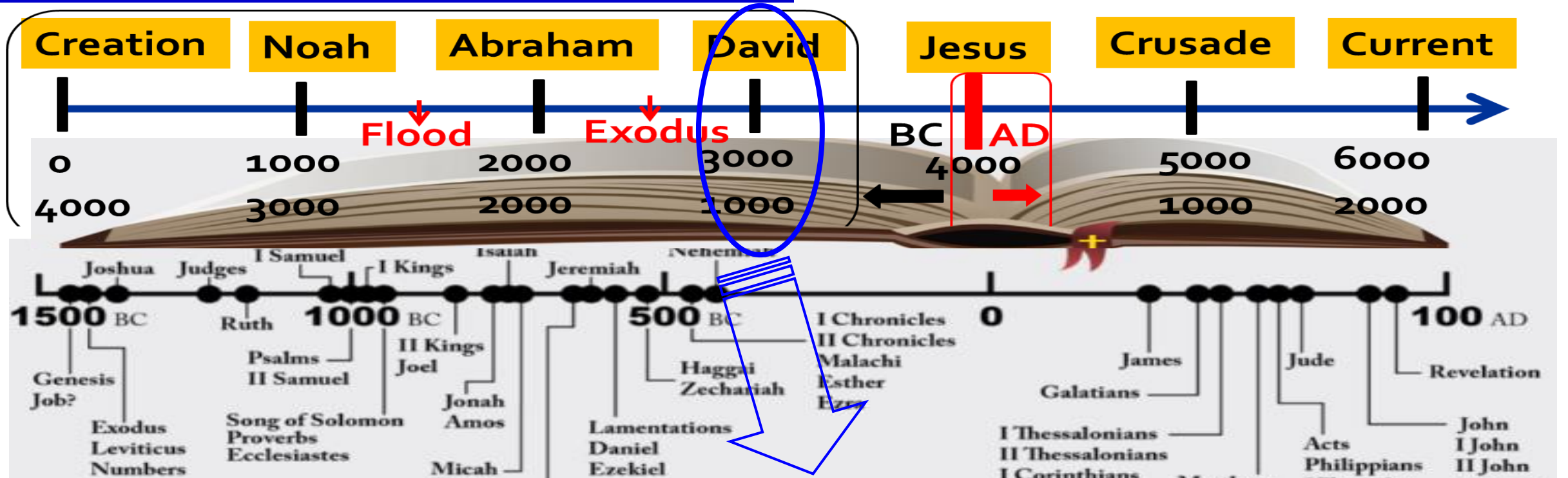

Amnon and Tamar

**“...Amnon son of David fell in love with Tamar,
the beautiful sister of Absalom son of David.**

**2 Amnon became so obsessed with ...Tamar that he
made himself ill... 3 Now Amnon had an adviser
named Jonadab ...a very shrewd man. 4 He asked**

**A “Absalom ordered his men,
“Listen! When Amnon is in high spirits
from drinking wine and I say to you,
‘Strike Amnon down,’ then kill him”**

-2 Sa 13:28-

Absalom's Conspiracy

“In the course of time, Absalom provided himself with a chariot ...stand by ...the city gate. Whenever anyone came with a complaint ...Absalom would say ...

“Look, your claims are valid ... but there is no representative of the king to hear you... If only I were appointed judge ...! Then ...I would see that they receive justice” ...

so he stole the hearts of the people of Israel” -2 Sa 15:1–6-

Absalom's Rebellion

**“A messenger ...told David,
“The hearts of the people ...are with Absalom.”**

...David said ...

**“Come! We must flee, or none of us will escape
from Absalom. We must leave immediately, or
he will move quickly to overtake us and bring ruin
on us and put the city to the sword.”**

**15 The king's officials answered ... “Your servants
are ready ... 16 The king set out, with his entire
household following him...”**

-2 Sa 15:13–16-

Absalom's Defeat

“While David was sitting between the inner and outer gates ...Then the Cushite arrived “...

The LORD has vindicated you ...from the hand of all who rose up against you.”

32 The king asked ...“Is the young man Absalom safe?” The Cushite replied, “May the enemies of my lord the king ...be like that young man.” 33 The king was shaken. He went up to the room over the gateway and wept... “O my son Absalom! ... If only I had died instead of you...”

Consequences...

**“His desire for prosperity and ease led him to trouble.
→ destroyed both his family and the nation”**
