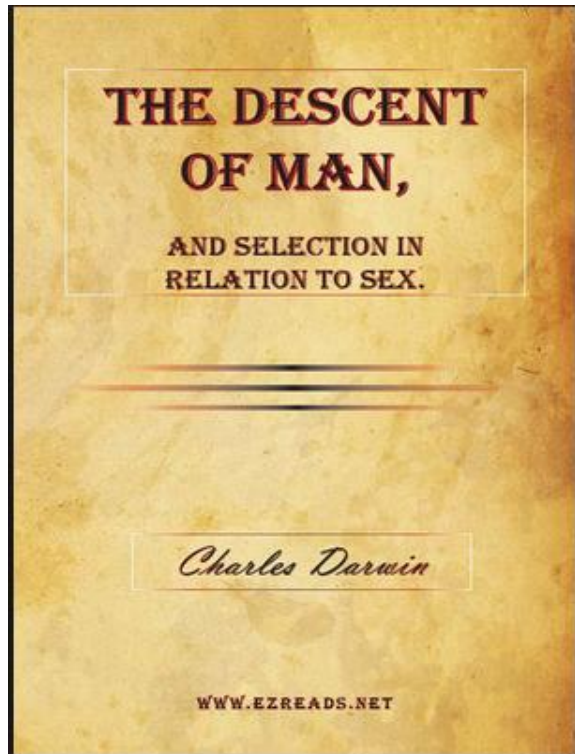
1837–1842)

EVOLUTION

Man's Place in Nature. — Although we know that man is separated mentally by a wide gap from all other animals, in our study of physiology we must ask where we are to place man. In our attempt to classify man, we see at once he must be placed with the vertebrate animals because of his possession of a vertebral column. Evidently, too, he is a mammal, because the young is nourished by milk secreted by the mother and because he has at least a partial covering of hair. Anatomically we must place man with the apelike mammals, because of the numerous points of structural likeness. The group which includes the monkeys, apes, and man we call the primates.

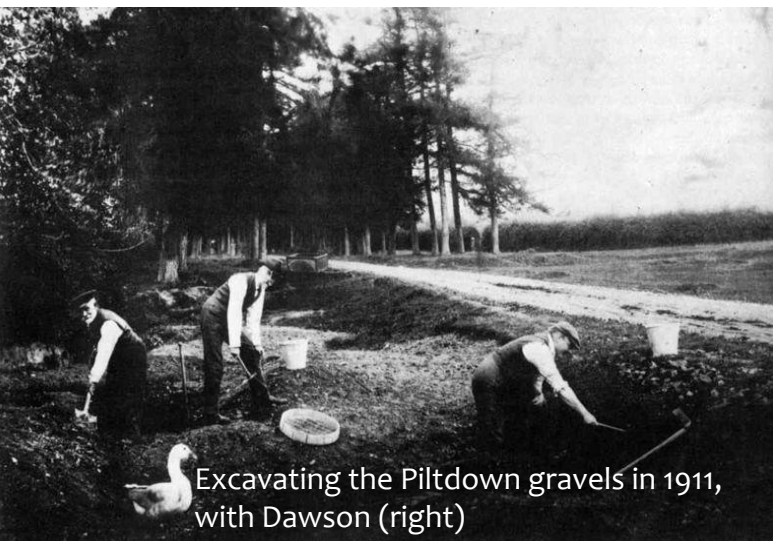
With the subjugation and domestication of animals began to take place. Man then began to cultivate the fields, and to have a fixed place of abode other than a cave. The beginnings of civilization were long ago, but even to-day the earth is not entirely civilized.

The Races of Man. — At the present time there exist upon the earth five races or varieties of man, each very different from the other in instincts, social customs, and, to an extent, in structure. These are the Ethiopian or negro type, originating in Africa; the Malay or brown race, from the islands of the Pacific; the American Indian; the Mongolian or yellow race, including the natives of China, Japan, and the Eskimos; and finally, the highest type of all, the Caucasians, represented by the civilized white inhabitants of Europe and America.

Piltdown Man...

1953, the ape-like jawbone was found to be a fraud.

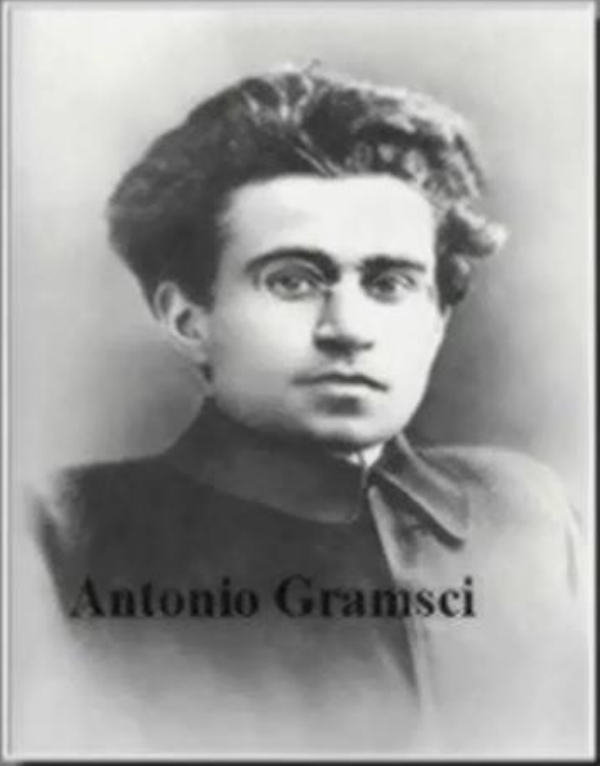

“Coerced sterilization is a shameful part of America’s history... As a means of controlling “undesirable” populations – immigrants, people of color, poor people, unmarried mothers ... federally-funded sterilization programs took place in 32 states ...particularly rampant in California : from 1909 and continuing for 70 years, California led the country in the number of sterilization ... often without their full knowledge and consent. Approximately 20,000 sterilizations took place ...”
