1 Samuel 8:1–8

1 When Samuel grew old, he appointed his sons as Israel's leaders. 2 The name of his firstborn was Joel and the name of his second was Abijah, and they served at Beersheba. 3 But his sons did not follow his ways. They turned aside after dishonest gain and accepted bribes and perverted justice. 4 So all the elders of Israel gathered together and came to Samuel at Ramah. 5 They said to him, "You are old, and your sons do not follow your ways; now appoint a king to lead us,

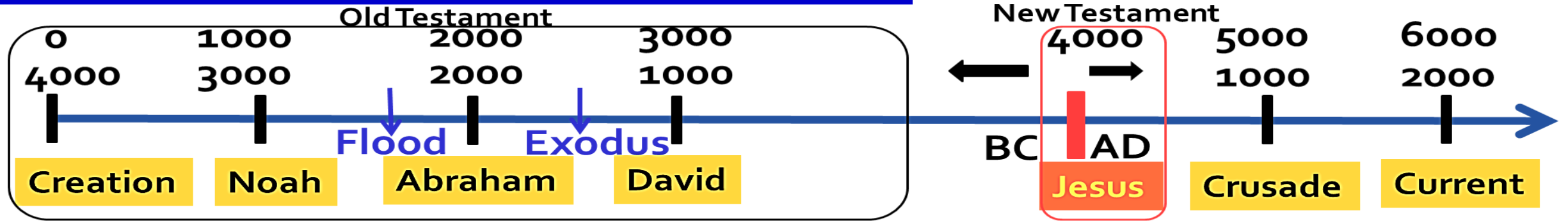
such as all the other nations have.”

6 But when they said, “Give us a king to lead us,” this displeased Samuel; so he prayed to the LORD. 7 And the LORD told him: “Listen to all that the people are saying to you; it is not you they have rejected, but they have rejected me as their king. 8 As they have done from the day I brought them up out of Egypt until this day, forsaking me and serving other gods, so they are doing to you.

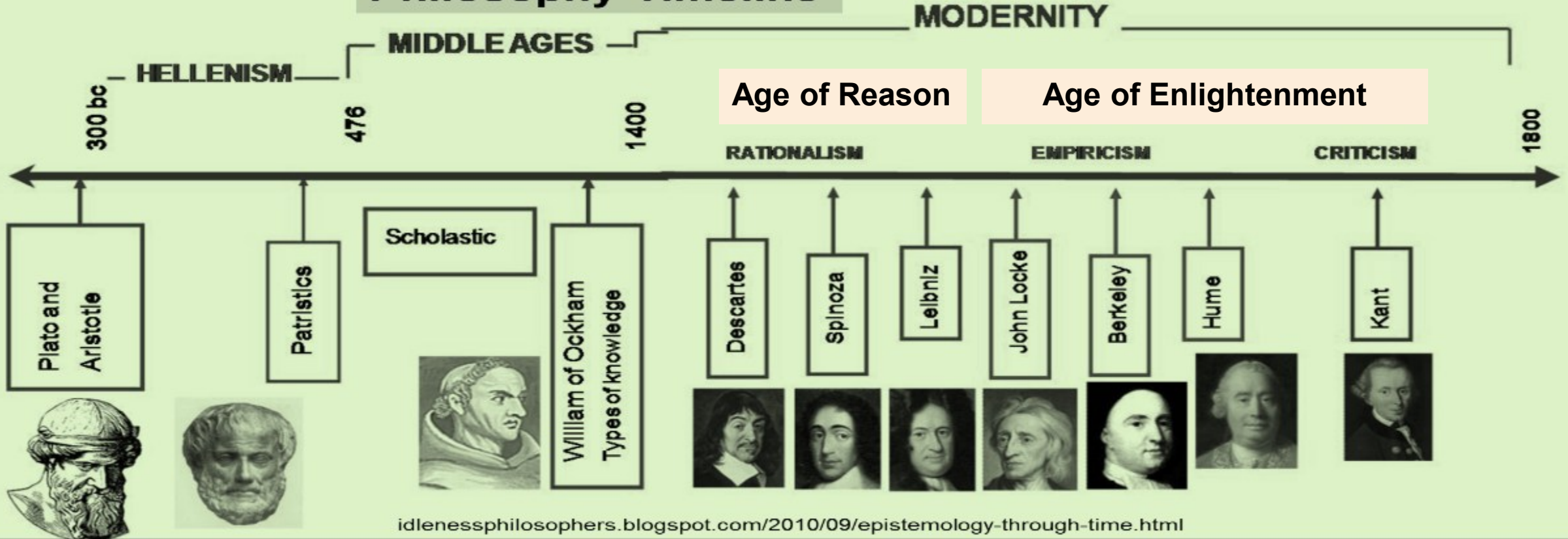

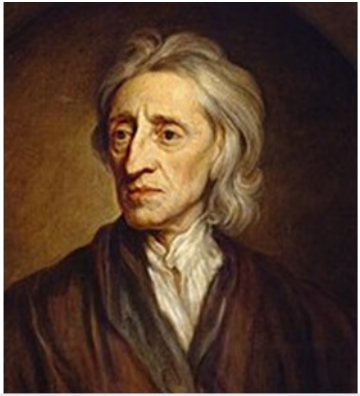

“Between 1838 and 1848, England was swept by an unprecedented wave of mass actions, political protests, and strikes.

Radical ideas were infecting the working class, leading many to expect (or fear) revolutionary change”

“Karl Marx (1818-1883) and Charles Darwin (1809-1882) were contemporaries whose works revolutionized their respective fields—Marx in economics and social theory, and Darwin in biology. Despite living less than 20 miles apart in England for much of their lives, they never met personally. However, their ideas intersected significantly...” -copilot search-
